The temple is just to the north of the H115,
 The cave has its origin in the book "Krai Thong" written by King Rama II. It is 1m wide, 1.5m long and 4m deep. A local tale is that over 65 years ago, a Buddhist monk of Wat Nakhon Chum walked with a candle into the cave and did not reach the end of the cave when the candle was burnt out. Therefore, nobody can tell how beautiful the cave inside is. At present the cave is less deep because it has been gradually destroyed by time. The statues of Krai Thong and Chalawan are installed at the cave entrance.
